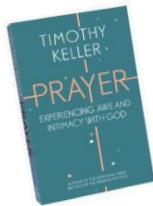

We couldn't understand why Isaac was so adamant that we find his green pouch. Seriously, why now?! At times, negotiating with a nearly-five-year-old is futile. But find it we did. And we still managed to get to the River Torrens for the 7am pyjama walk – a fundraiser for an orphanage in East China that some good friends are involved in.

“Aunty T\*\*...” Isaac said, tapping her elbow, as he looked up trying to get her attention. All eyes were on Isaac. He looked quite pensive. After unzipping the green pouch, he produced two other smaller pouches - “...this is for the orphanage” he said quietly, as the entire contents of about \$1.70 worth of silver coins tumbled into T\*\*’s now open palms. “All of it? Are you sure, Isaac?” T\*\* questioned, still quite stunned. “Yes, it’s for the orphans.”

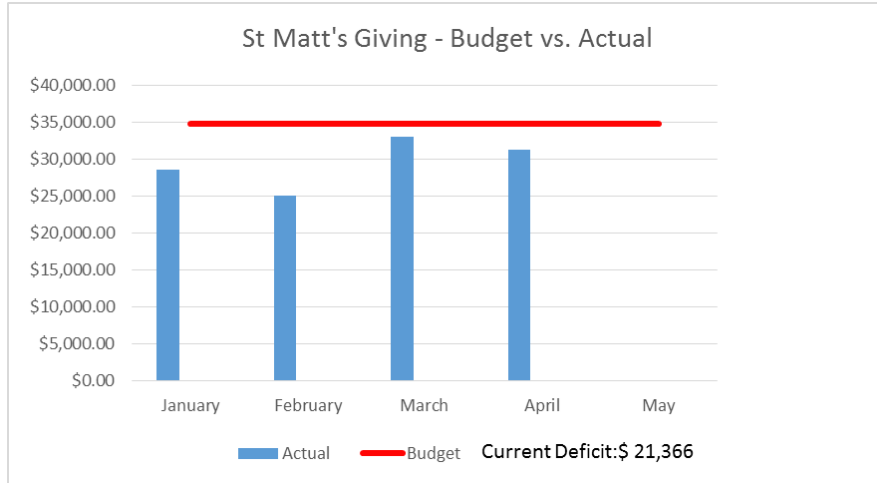
It was a beautiful moment. We hadn't prepped him to do this – he was just putting into practice our family maxim of “loving people more than things.” His display of extravagant, heart-felt, compassionate generosity warmed my heart and reminded me of what Christ has done for us.
